This is why they are asking Governor Holcomb to call a **special session of the Legislature.**

IS IT POSSIBLE FOR CONNECTICUT WOMEN TO BE GIVEN TO BE GIVEN BY MEN OUTSIDE OUR STATE?

Yes, if Connecticut is not among the 36 states to ratify the Federal Suffrage Amendment. 22 states have already ratified. Others are acting now.

HAS GOVERNOR HOLCOMB EVER CALLED A SPECIAL SESSION?

Yes; twice. In 1916 and in 1918.

What was his reason?

To provide for the vote of men in service.

DID THE STATE APPROVE OF THE GOVERNOR'S ACTION?

Yes.

DOES THE STATE APPROVE OF ANOTHER SPECIAL SESSION?

Yes; 61% of the legislators have petitioned the Governor to call this session.
