In reply to your letter of April 9th, allow me to say that the National American Woman Suffrage Association has never endorsed and never proposes to endorse any amendment to the federal constitution which deals with the

qualification of the voter. It is well understood that that is a question assigned to the states. We stand for the removal of the sex restriction, nothing more, nothing less.
